WISCONSIN NOW REQUIRES A PHOTO ID TO VOTE

Starting in 2012, Wisconsin state law requires voters to present photo identification prior to voting. The following is a list of acceptable forms of photo identification (note: photo ID does NOT need to show current address):

- Wisconsin Drivers License expiring after 11/2/2010
- Wisconsin DOT issued photo ID card expiring after 11/2/2010
- U.S. Passport expiring after 11/2/2010
- Military ID card expiring after 11/2/2010
- Certificate of Naturalization issued within last 2 years
- Unexpired Wisconsin drivers license or state ID receipt
- ID card issued by a federally recognized Indian tribe in Wisconsin
- Unexpired ID issued by a Wisconsin accredited university or college -must contain issuance date, student signature, and expiration date within 2 years of issuance along with proof of current enrollment.
